## **Problem Behavior Interventions/Strategies**

### **Breaks**

Take a Break or Give Frequent Breaks Move seat in class Send student on errand Snack break

### Consequences

Avoid power struggles Call parent or note home Classroom management system Clear, consistent, and predictable consequences Do unfinished work during recess **Reflection/Think sheet** In Class or Cross Team Time Out Speak in calm and neutral tone Take away privileges **Minor Referral** 

## **Praise**

Acknowledging positive behavior Praise student frequently Praise when cooperative and well behaved Praise when on task

## Other

Alternate Seating In Own Space Alternative modes of completing assignments Assign a peer partner Assign a classroom job Break down assignment Break down directions Call on student frequently Clear and concise directions Count to 10 Write in agenda **Deep breathing** Draw a picture or write in a journal **Engage student Explain** assignment **Explain directions** Frequent eye contact Frequent home contact Give choices Have student repeat directions back Headphones Interventions and Strategies are from PBISWorld.org
