June 10	Participants will engage in an MTSS Framework designed to identify students not on track and provide tiered interventions and supports. The goal will be to use an early warning system around attendance, behavior, and course performance data to make informed decisions that help students meet their goals. Resources and tools will be provided to help schools align practices, effectively action plan, establish decision rules, review and analyze data, decrease chronic absenteeism/severe behavior occurrences and improve teaming structures in order to implement a multi-tiered system of supports.
June 11	Al Workshop  The AI workshop will focus on the role and implementation of AI in an educational setting. In an ever-changing and evolving technological landscape, AI is set to become the most innovative and progressive change in education since the introduction of the home computer. This workshop will cover the basics of AI, strategies for implementation of AI in the classroom, and a workshop on policies every school should consider adopting! (Gifted Hours)
June 12	Admin Workshop  Admin workshop will address current topics in education, including MTSS, EWS, and PBIS. We will also include topics on parent engagement and vaping. Additionally, time will be available for networking and discussion.
June 13	Developed by the American Lung Association in partnership with the Prevention Research Center of West Virginia University, INDEPTH (Intervention for Nicotine Dependence: Education, Prevention, Tobacco, and Health) is a convenient alternative to suspension that helps schools and communities address the teen vaping problem in a supportive way. Instead of solely focusing on punitive measures, INDEPTH is an interactive program that teaches students about nicotine dependence, establishing healthy alternatives, and how to kick the unhealthy addiction that got them in trouble in the first place. Upon successful completion of the INDEPTH training, facilitators will receive a 3-year certification, access to the INDEPTH Facilitator Guide, and resources to plan and implement the program.
